Kathmandu Durbar Square: A historic and cultural hub, Kathmandu Durbar Square is a UNESCO World Heritage Site that offers a glimpse into Nepal's royal past. Once the seat of the Malla and Shah kings, the square is home to magnificent palaces, intricately carved temples, and vibrant courtyards. The 17th-century Hanuman Dhoka Palace, the towering Taleju Temple, and the residence of the Living Goddess, Kumari, are among its highlights. Strolling through the square, visitors can witness centuries-old traditions, bustling local markets, and artisans crafting metalwork and wooden carvings.

Swayambhunath: One of the most sacred Buddhist sites in Nepal, Swayambhunath, or the Monkey Temple, sits atop a forested hill overlooking Kathmandu Valley. The golden stupa, adorned with Buddha's watchful eyes, radiates spiritual energy, drawing monks, pilgrims, and travelers alike. Prayer flags flutter in the wind, and the air is filled with the soft hum of prayer wheels and chanting. The climb to the top is rewarded with a breathtaking panoramic view of the valley, making it a must-visit landmark.
